An international meeting ground for organizations and individuals engaged in injury prevention, training, research, and policy

Injury is a major cause of child and adolescent death and disability throughout the world. International experience has shown that most injuries are not accidents: injuries and deaths can be prevented, often by simple, available measures.

In 1993, injury specialists, researchers, policy makers, educators, medical personnel and advocates established The International Society for Child and Adolescent Injury Prevention (ISCAIP) to improve global dialogue and action for preventing and controlling child and adolescent injuries. The Society addresses both intentional and unintentional injuries.

ISCAIP GOAL:

PROMOTE A REDUCTION IN THE GLOBAL BURDEN OF INJURIES TO CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS THROUGH INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION.

The objectives of this society are:

- To provide a multidisciplinary forum for global dialogue
- To assist in providing advocacy at national and international levels
- To foster national and international injury prevention initiatives
- To stimulate the translation of research findings into programs and policies
- To facilitate collaborative and interdisciplinary international research

MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

The Society promotes the exchange of ideas, science, and experience among members to facilitate international collaborations, activities, and seminars on research, programming, and policy.

GOVERNANCE

A Board, comprised of elected officers and representatives from the following regions – Africa, Americas, Asia, Australasia, and Europe, governs the Society. The editor of the journal *Injury Prevention* is an ex-officio member of the Executive Board. The term of Board members is 3 years. All members are eligible for election to the

Board. In addition, multiple committees allow for the active involvement of all interested members.

ISCAIP MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Society is open to any person with an interest or involvement in the prevention, treatment, or research of injuries to children and adolescents. Injury prevention is a multidisciplinary endeavor and the ISCAIP membership reflects a broad range of interests and expertise. Members include health practitioners, researchers, educators, engineers, architects, legislators, public safety professionals, media, students and representatives from the private sector or government institutions. The Society is equally interested in having participation from both the developed and the developing world.
